Essentially the course is designed to encourage professional growth at departmental and school levels. Teachers will be involved in an action learning cycle that focuses **on curriculum leadership and managing change (including confronting and managing power relationships in schools), the development of successful sustainable language programmes within schools, and on mentoring in languages education.**

The programme involves a series of five full day workshops spread across the academic year together with action learning and planning within a whole school context. Please see dates below. Teachers will also be involved in an online unit (FLOTE) which can allow for accreditation towards a **Masters Degree** at Murdoch University.
