

Sticker Competition 2021

The Teachers of French Association invites **students from Year 1-10** to participate in the annual TOFA Sticker Competition.

Theme

The topic of this year's competition is "Eux aussi, ils parlent français!". See the document "La Francophonie - Guide pédagogique" for ideas on how to approach this theme in French class.

Rules

- It's easy to participate! Each student creates a design into the circle of the attached participation sheet.
- The winning artwork will be made into a 2.5cm

 Sticker. It is important that the designs and writing are simple and clear and the words are spelled correctly.
- Longer text (5 words+) can be typed up and glued on as neatly as possible into the circle.
- Please prompt your students to use bright colours, outline shapes and letters and remove all pencil traces.
- Important: The artwork must be an original design created by the student. Copying, tracing from the internet or books could infringe copyright!
- The participation sheets need to be signed by teacher AND student, as it is important that TOFA has got the consent to publish the student's artwork and name. (We only use students first names and initials on all our internet publications).
- A MAXIMUM of 5 designs can be submitted per category/teacher. Please send in your entries in a plastic sleeve (for weather protection)
